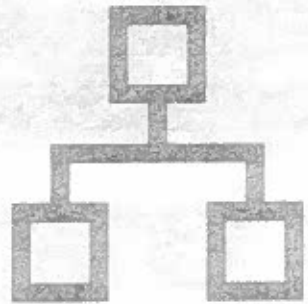

During Class



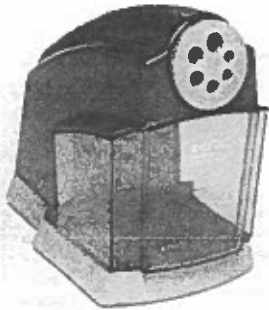
- Be prepared for instruction.

- Everyone's hands and feet should remain to themselves.



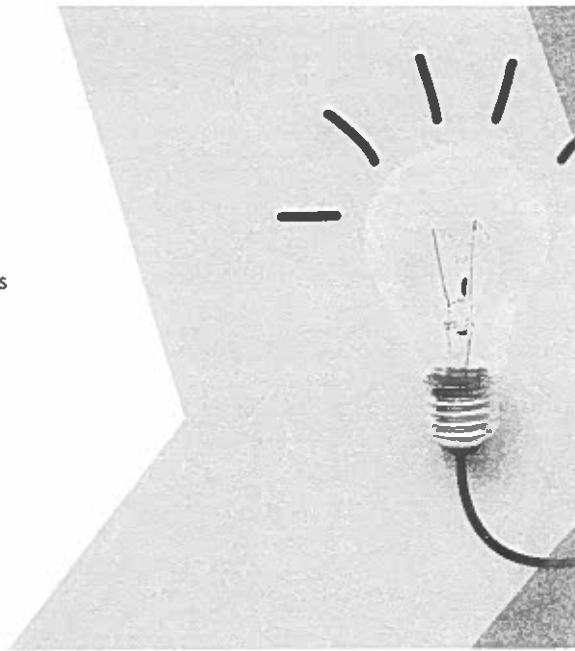
Restroom Procedures

Course Goals:

- To develop responsibility and personal advocacy
